1. The above range of fees are for the purposes of estimating only and the fees for the work you are instructing a Barrister to do can only be agreed on receipt of the full case papers.
2. Chambers operates a flexible fee policy, and the Practice Management Team are happy to discuss fees with you in respect of your case and circumstances prior to you instructing a Barrister.
3. Once the fees have been agreed, the fees are payable before the Barrister can begin work on your case.
4. You will be provided with a Client Care letter at each stage of the case which will set out the additional costs for further work which means you will be continuously and fully informed at each stage of the case as to what the costs of the Barrister's fees will be.
5. The fees charged may vary depending on the issues involved in your case, for example a higher fee will be charged in more complex cases.
6. The above fees apply to local courts and so there may be additional travel costs charged for Courts outside of Manchester. This will be confirmed in your Client Care letter.
7. VAT will be charged to the Barrister's fees where applicable. Please advise if your case is exempt from VAT and on which basis otherwise VAT will be charged on all fees unless we are notified otherwise.
8. There may be times when the circumstances of the case may mean the fees could be subject to change such as whether the hearing is listed in-person or remotely; or when a hearing is adjourned and relisted on an alternative date.
9. There may be additional fees which you will need to pay in addition to the Barrister's fees, such as the Court and Tribunal Fees. More information can be found on the Court and Tribunal Fees page on the Gov.uk website at <https://www.gov.uk/court-fees-what-they-are>
10. We aim to complete work within 7 days of receipt of all the papers and confirmation of instruction. Where this is not possible or an alternative time frame is required, for example due to a Court deadline, we will agree the timeframe for the completion of the work with you.
